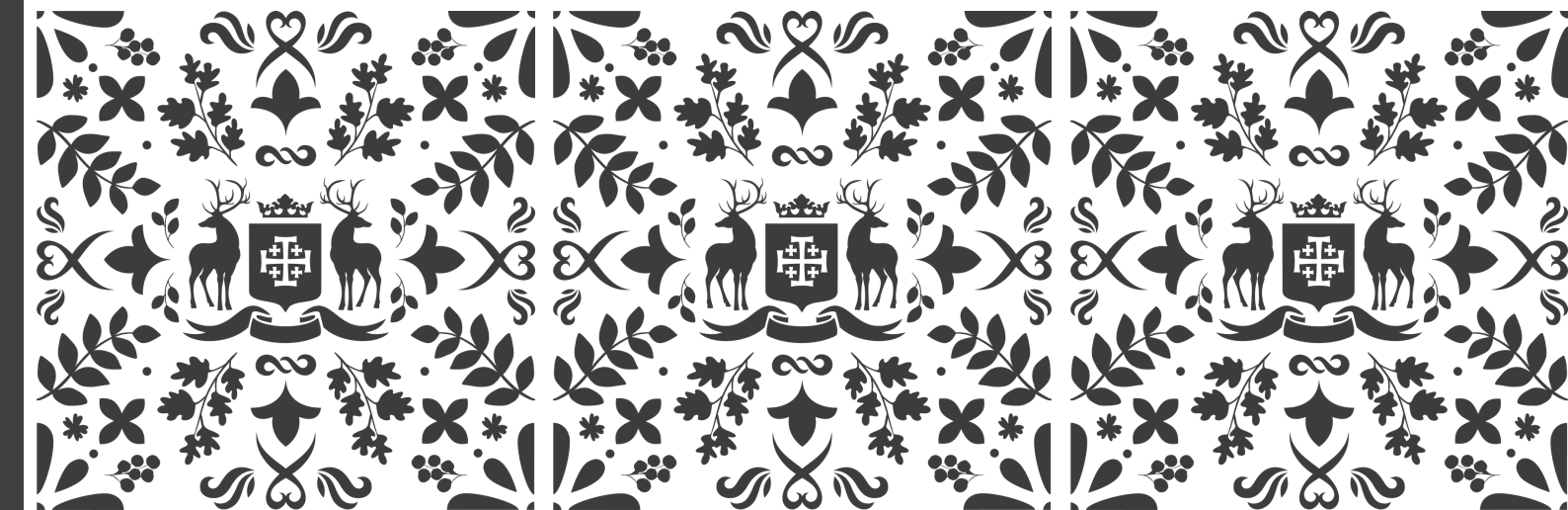

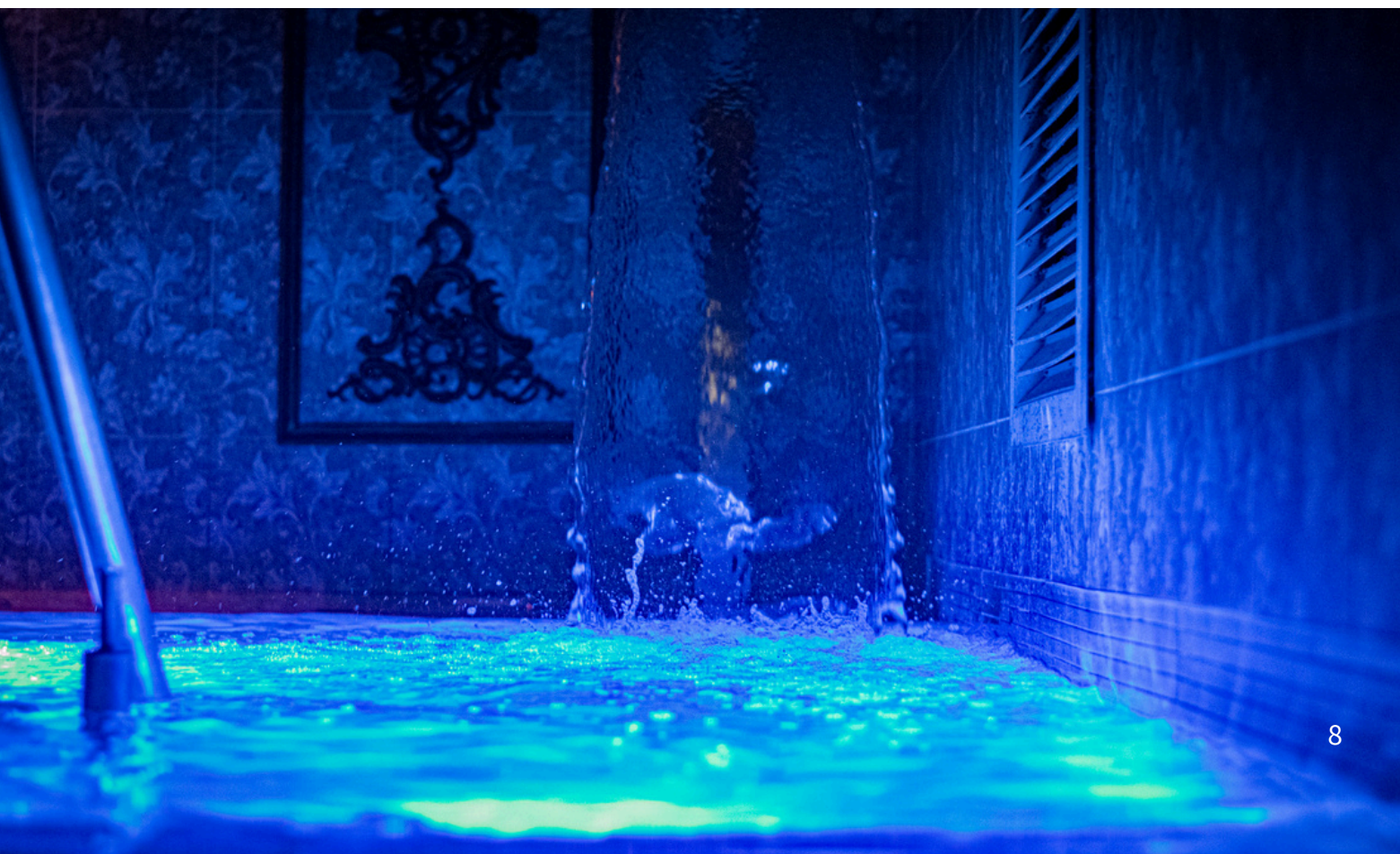

THE RICH HERITAGE OF CORICK HOUSE

The Clogher Valley, steeped in history, has been home to settlers since ancient times, evident in its standing stones and chambered graves. Fertile farmland stretches across the valley, rising to the rolling moors in the north and south. The name Corick (or Corag), meaning "a confluence of streams," traces back to the early 17th century when these lands were granted to the Bishop of Clogher during the Plantation of Ulster in 1610. The estate, covering nearly 220 acres, stands at the meeting point of the Fury River—flowing from the Monaghan border—and the Tyrone Blackwater.

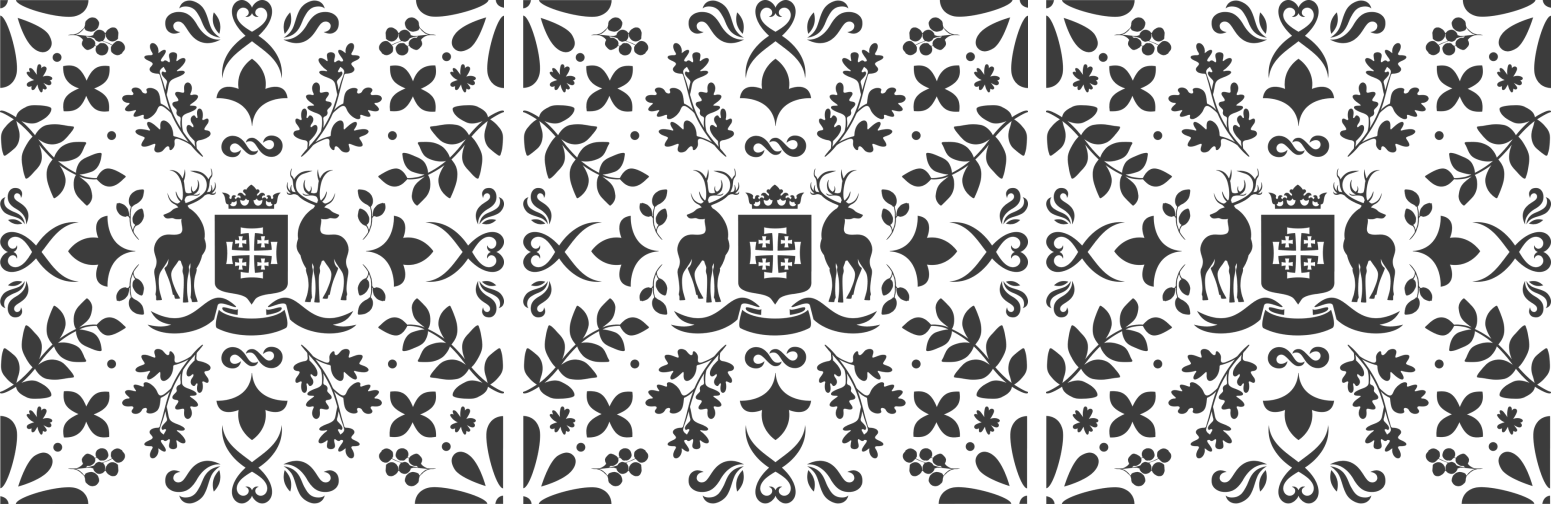
In 1697, Bishop St. George Ashe settled John Story from Hexham, Northumberland, on the property. Story, who had sold his estate at Bingfield Hall, came to Ireland as the Bishop's agent. Over time, he and his son, Thomas Story, amassed an estate of more than 3,000 acres under the See of Clogher. At Corick, they built their first mansion, establishing a lineage that would be intertwined with the estate for nearly 300 years.

The Story family played a pivotal role in Corick's development, serving as Bishop's agents, clergymen, and farmers. In the early 19th century, the novelist William Carleton's parents were tenants of John Benjamin Story (1764–1844) at Nurchossy. Carleton later referenced Story in *Traits and Stories*, describing him as one of the most distinguished and handsome local squires.

Throughout the 19th century, the Story family continued to enhance Corick, planting trees and establishing the walled garden. In 1863, under William Story's direction, the house was significantly expanded and redesigned by the renowned Belfast architect Sir Charles Lanyon. This transformation introduced a striking new garden façade with a large canted bay window and a three-story Italianate-style tower with a hipped slate roof, while the original dining room remained untouched.

Corick House remained a family estate until 1994, when the house and gardens were sold to Mrs. Jean Beacom, while the surrounding farmland was acquired by local farmers. Two years later, in 1996, Corick House opened its doors as a guesthouse with nine rooms, fulfilling Mrs. Beacom's vision of preserving the grandeur and traditions of this historic Irish home.

Today, her legacy continues through her children, Avril, Haldene, Andrew, and their family, who have undertaken an extensive program of improvements. Committed to maintaining the elegance and heritage of Corick House, they seamlessly blend traditional Irish hospitality with contemporary sophistication, ensuring this timeless estate remains a cherished destination for generations to come.
